

## VILLAGE SPORT CO-ORDINATORS

Active Norfolk are looking to appoint Village Sport Co-ordinators across the County as part of the Norfolk Village Games project. These posts will receive a £300 yearly payment with a further £200 available for justifiable expenses. There is also the potential for funding to be available to each co-ordinator to work on any agreed project.

Appointed co-ordinators will encourage the development of sport in their village/rural area, a role that will include **some** of the following activities:

- *inspire an entry into your districts Village Games;*
- *be a focal point for sporting information in the village and a 'Champion for Sport' liaising with local organisations such as Parish Councils or Playing Field Committees;*
- *With your Rural Sports Development Officer co-ordinate a Village Come-and-Try or Activity Day to encourage more people to take part in sport and the games itself*

In the future and with support from Active Norfolk and the Rural Sports Development Officers, together we will work towards **some** of goals below;

- *form an organising group to receive external grants for village sporting projects;*
- *form an organising group to arrange coaching courses and activities for young people and/or other village residents;*
- *co-ordinate a transport scheme to a sporting facility/activity;*

We are looking for people who are keen to organise activities themselves, but also people who can encourage and motivate others to get involved and take a lead as well. Does this sound like you?

If you are performing some or all of these responsibilities already- we want to hear from you!! With our help it may be possible to increase what you can do in your local area and we may be able to offer you the chance to learn a new skill or start a new club for example.
