**Suffolk Discrimination Law Service** are holding a free Discrimination Advice Clinic at Norwich Community Law Service, Boardman House, Redwell Street, Norwich NR2 4SL. Please phone **SDLS 01473 408111** and ask for Letha Evelyn for an appointment or enquire at **Norwich Community Law Service office**.

**DISCRIMINATION IS:** When someone treats you worse than they treat other people because of your race, sex, religion or belief, age, sexual orientation, gender, disabled or care for someone who is disabled or undergoing gender reassignment. Discrimination is **unlawful** at work, at school and in relation to anyone providing goods and services.

### Free & independent legal advice for victims of domestic abuse

Working with Leeway and Norwich City Council, NCLS is offering appointments with a solicitor for legal advice and assistance on all types of civil injunction. **Appointments available alternate Wednesdays between 10am and 1pm.** Please call the NCLS office.

Available throughout Norfolk for offenders, ex-offenders and their families, young people aged 16 – 25 years and to clients who currently have a support worker.

### Migrant Worker Advice

We can provide free and independent advice to migrant workers on issues such as employment, discrimination and benefits.

### Mediation Service

Service currently for Norwich City Council housing tenants; to try to prevent repossession hearings for rent arrears. Available to all social landlords.
